THINK

The written Word of God was to be a part of their lives. The Scripture they received was the result of someone being obedient to God's commands to provide it for them. What they received was not to stay with them. They were to copy it and pass it on ("cause that it be read also").

The Word of God cannot reproduce itself. A Bible cannot produce a Bible. That is why God has given the church the responsibility to preserve His Word and reproduce it.

The Word of God cannot move itself. It needs a carrier. It may be by plane, by truck, by mail, or by a missionary. Missionaries need the Word of God to get the job done (Romans 10:17).

More than likely, you own a Bible. As a matter of fact, you may have even more than one. What a privilege it is to have a copy of God's Word, but so many people in the world are still waiting to even see their first copy of God's Word. It has been provided, protected, and preserved for us. Now, we must give together and work together to publish God's Word around the world...that all the earth may know!




LESSON FOUR

God's Purpose For Providing His Word to Every Generation



THINK

We have seen in the previous three lessons that God wanted to reveal Himself to mankind, and He ultimately did so through the written Word of God. Then, we learned that something as valuable as His Word should be handled in a very specific way. We also saw that if that were going to take place consistently, then a very particular group of people should be involved in the process. Now, we are going to look at the next step. Why did God command His people to produce His Word to an entire world?

There can be no debate that God expects every Christian to publish His words to people who have not heard. There are many verses that teach us that truth. Matthew 28:19-20, Mark 16:15, Luke 24:44-47, and Acts 1:8 are just a few to which we commonly refer. The part of publishing Scriptures that has been greatly left out in the modern era of the church (which was a part of life to the early Christians) is the copying and passing on of the Scriptures they received.

Habakkuk 2:2
